We do not build cars for stock, as each vehicle is prepared to the customers own specification. It takes between six and eight months from time of order to delivery. Should you wish, we can build a car to exactly match Jaguars original vehicle as our Benson and Hedges, Champion of Champions V12 E type proves. However, the majority of our customers ask that their cars be upgraded to meet modern motoring needs incorporating lead free operation, air conditioning, alarms, central locking and superb in-car entertainment systems.







Naturally, the price of our cars will be dependent on the options fitted. Given your exact specification we can give you a firm quotation for a car that is unique to you. The price listed is for us to provide a donor vehicle. However, should you wish to supply your own Jaguar for restoration, then the price would be adjusted accordingly. Should any options not listed, be required, please tell us and our engineers will endeavour to accommodate your needs.



The cost of restoration

The cost of each restoration can be completely different, as it is dependent on the specification that you require and the condition of the donor vehicle.

We appreciate that our customers need to have an accurate quotation before the restoration process begins. A list of optional extras is enclosed and, once you have made your choice of your own unique specification, a firm quotation will be given.

All our restorations carry a five year anti-corrosion warranty and a 12 months mechanical warranty.



Once the car has been sourced, supplied either by us or yourself, the vehicle would be completely stripped, every nut and bolt being removed. The body shell would then be placed onto a jig for examination and any necessary chassis and bodywork rectification carried out. On rebuilding the car new parts are used for all the nuts, bolts, washers and perishable items. Other items are either replaced with new or refurbished as appropriate.



There is a choice of engines, either original or lead-free. Upgrade work is carried out by engine specialists. All engines are then thoroughly tested so as to gain a perfect balance and smooth running.

The dashboards are carefully assembled with either Vicarage or original instruments together with either original or wood veneers. The interior leather work is carried out by upholstery specialists to your own personal choice.



Travelling by car, leave M6 motorway at junction 12 onto A5 proceeding towards Telford. At the first island turn left onto the A449 and proceed along A449 for one and a half miles. Turn left at Four Ashes Public House. Having travelled along Station Road and under the railway bridge take second turning on the right into Enterprise Drive. First right takes you into Aspley Close, the home of VICARAGE.

Should you wish to travel by air into Birmingham International Airport or rail into Wolverhampton or Stafford stations, we would be most pleased to collect you. Overnight accommodation can be arranged on request.
